RAFTER'S RESPONSIBILITY: When choosing a river trip for you and your group, be realistic about everyone's abilities. Please be sure to ask questions, and if others in your party have questions, please have them call a reservations specialist (877-747-7238) so that we may answer their questions directly.

You participate in rafting and related activities at your own risk, and we ask that you choose a trip within your and your groups personal limits. Anyone within your group with any medical conditions, physical limitations, is seriously overweight, PREGNANT or presumed to be pregnant should consult a physician prior to any river trip. All participants are required to sign a release and indemnity agreement and acknowledgement and assumption of risk form.

Cancellation Policy: KODI Rafting welcomes and tries to accommodate all walk-ins, but it is always recommended to make an advance reservation to guarantee space. If a reservation is cancelled prior to 7 days before your scheduled trip, a \$10/person administrative fee is charged. Within 7 days, guests are subject to a 50% charge. As rafting trips require advance preparation, no refunds will be given for cancellations made within 24 hours of scheduled trip.

With groups of 10 or more a 50% non-refundable deposit is needed to reserve the trip, with the remaining 50% due on the date of the trip. Cancellations within 14 days of the rafting trip will be charged an additional 25% (75% of the total trip price), and groups canceling within 7 days of the trip will be charged in full.

We operate under special use permits from the White River National Forest, USDA Forest Service, BLM and the Colorado Department of Parks. All KODI trips are subject to use land and water permit fees which vary by river and managing agency. KODI Rafting is an equal opportunity service provider. Colorado River Outfitter License #0363. Due to changes in water flows and conditions, trip difficulty, classification, and minimum ages may vary. Children's prices are for ages 12 and under.

Browns Canyon Overnight

Let our guides take your personal gear via raft to a remote campsite in Browns Canyon, where you will meet up with them after a half day of paddling and taking in the scenery. Once at camp you can fish, hike, play riverside games or just relax in the peaceful setting while your guides prepare dinner. On day two, you will encounter the remainder of the Class III Canyon, and float to our take-out at the base of 14,000 foot Mt. Shavano. All meals included. Minimum age is 7.

The Narrows

Enjoy the spectacular scenery of Colorado's majestic 14,000-foot Collegiate Peaks in this remote section of the Arkansas River. This is a technically challenging Class IV trip and starts with the Miracle Mile, before reaching Frog Rock and House Rock. After a hearty lunch along the river we'll finish off the day with the Silver Bullet, and then a relaxing Class I-II float into the take out. Minimum age is 12.

Browns Canyon Full & Half Day - Our most popular trip!

Experience rafting on the Arkansas River at its best. This Class III trip is ideal for the first time boater or the veteran paddler, combining the perfect mix of whitewater, calm water, and majestic scenery and is one of the world's most popular stretches of river. Enjoy rapids like Pinball, Widowmaker, and Zoom Flume in this beautiful granite canyon. Minimum age is 7.

These boats hold a capacity of three boaters (including the guide). You will be sitting in the seat of adventure for this trip. This is a high adventure trip, so plan on getting wet! Minimum age for this trip is 16 and previous paddling experience is recommended.

WHAT TO WEAR

Avoid cotton, jeans & long pants if possible. Comfortable, quick-drying clothing is best. Any outdoor gear, such as neoprene, polypropylene, wool, or fleece is suggested. KODI offers wetsuits, booties and splash tops if you would like some extra protection. You'll also want to bring hats, sunscreen, sunglasses and tennis shoes (that you don't mind getting wet) or rubber-soled attachable (no flip-flops) sport sandals.

CLEAR CREEK

Beginner 1/3 Day

Great for families and beginners alike, this trip takes you through the historic mining town of Idaho Springs. While taking on the splashy waters of Clear Creek, you will be able to observe abandoned mines, a historic water wheel and have a chance to see some desert bighorn sheep. Wetsuits are included on this trip. Minimum age is 7.

Intermediate 1/2 Day

This trip will start out with a short stretch of some Class II water to warm up your paddling muscles before you start your whitewater experience with Rodeo Rapid. Before you know it, you'll have navigated Nomad, Fall River, Deliverance and Outer Limits, to name a few. You'll then be able to enjoy the float through the historic mining town of Idaho Springs. Wetsuits are included on this trip. Minimum age is 14.

Whitewater adventure

Advanced 1/2 Day

This is an action packed whitewater trip for experienced paddlers or those with a true sense of adventure. Tight, steep and technical are the three best words used to describe this trip. This trip will start out with Meat-n-Beef and Lumpys (both rapids are .7 miles long!) From there we'll continue through a series of continuous Class II-IV whitewater, before taking out in the historic mining town of Idaho Springs. Wetsuits are included on this trip. Minimum age is 16.

Departs Clear Creek Outpost at 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.

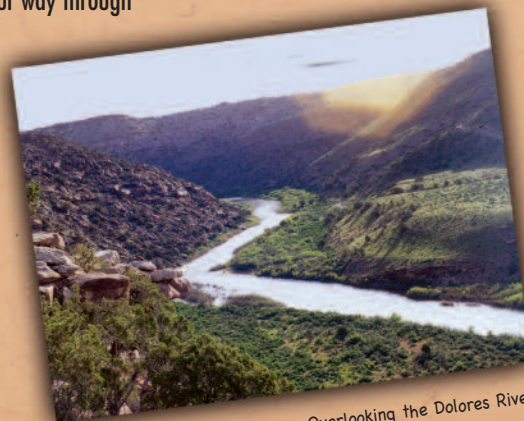

DOLORES RIVER 3-DAY

Nestled in one of the lesser-known parts of Colorado, the 47-mile Dolores trip is a gem. From the Ponderosa forest to the mountain desert, this trip offers variety unlike any other. KODI's two night, three-day Dolores trip starts at an elevation of 6,400 feet, at Bradfield Bridge and continues down to Slickrock. You will experience the unsurpassed beauty of the Ponderosa forest as you maneuver your way through the Class I-II waters. On day two the "real whitewater fun begins as you encounter one of the classic rapids of the West, Class IV – Snaggletooth. But the fun doesn't stop there as Three Mile Rapid is just around the bend. During your three days on this beautiful river, you will see how it once was in Anasazi time, and experience ruins and petroglyphs. This trip usually supplies a great dose of wildlife including Bighorn Sheep, Mule Deer, River Otters, Peregrine Falcons, Bald Eagles, and some of the most common wildlife, your guides! All meals included. Available April - early June only. All Dolores Trips meet in Cortez, CO. Minimum age is 10.

Numbers Full & Half Day

Experience seven major rapids in seven quick miles on this narrow, rocky and steep section of the Arkansas. The trip requires plenty of maneuvering as you attempt to conquer rapids #1 - #7. This Class IV trip is not for the faint of heart, and previous paddling experience is recommended. Lunch is provided on the full day and will either continue through the Narrows or brave the rapids of Browns Canyon in the afternoon – depending on water levels. Minimum age is 16.

Royal Gorge Full Day

Challenging Class IV rapids such as Sledgehammer, Wall Slammer and Boat Eater at the bottom of an 1100-foot deep gorge make this one of Colorado's most exciting whitewater adventures. This trip runs through the Class III Bighorn Sheep Canyon and includes a riverside lunch. Minimum age is 16.

Meet at 10:00 a.m. in Cañon City.

Colorado River Overnight

A 17-mile long trip through Little Gore Canyon and beyond! This is the perfect quick getaway – two days of rafting down a relaxing river while encountering Class II rapids throughout the trip. The Colorado Overnight takes you past natural hot springs, old homestead cabins, and dinosaur tracks. The first afternoon, we stop and make camp alongside the river while you relax, play camp games or read a good book. All meals are included. Minimum age is 5.

COLORADO RIVER

Full and Half Day

Just downstream of the headwaters of the mighty Colorado River, this Class II trip is gentle and perfect for all ages. The Colorado meanders its way through Little Gore Canyon, where you will encounter a few small rapids before the canyon opens up and you can take a swim. Great for families with younger kids, or those just looking for a relaxing trip along a diverse and scenic stretch of river, the Upper Colorado River trip takes guests past natural hot springs and historical mining cabins. On the full day trip, we stop for a short hike to dinosaur tracks (time permitting), and serve up a cheese tortellini riverside lunch. If you are looking for an introduction to rafting, the Upper Colorado is a great place to start. Minimum age is 4 or 40 lbs.

Inflatable Kayak / Duckie Trips

Duckies are a great way to experience the thrill of maneuvering your own "boat" down the river. Inflatable one or two person kayaks, duckies give you the opportunity to guide your own boat! All duckie trips are guided and take place on the Colorado River. No experience necessary. Minimum age is 14.

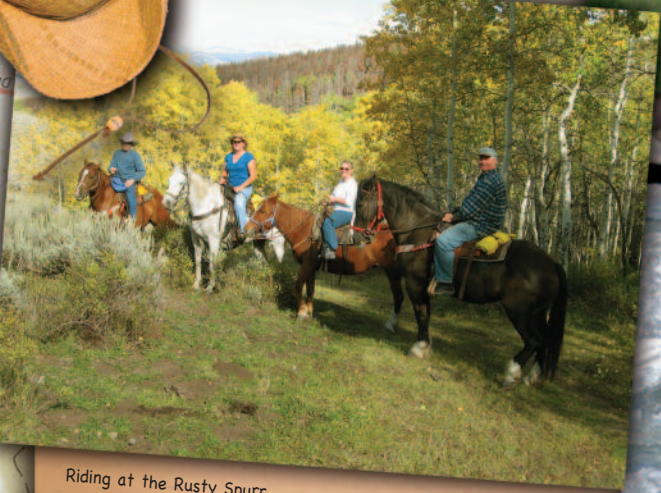

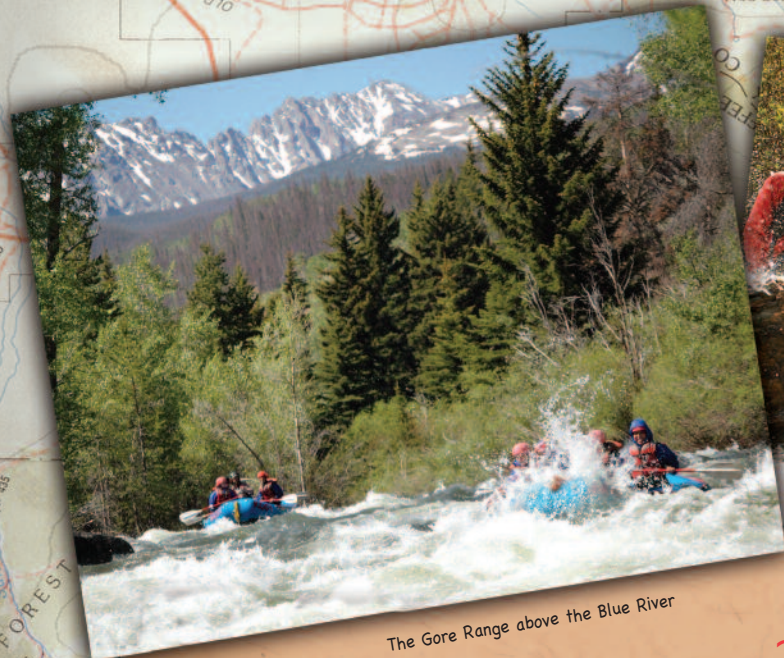

Guests will enjoy a two-hour guided trail ride surrounded by breath-taking views of the mountains on the sage covered high desert, to the sheltered tranquility of the aspen and evergreen-filled mountain forests. After a hearty lunch at the Ranch, guests will be shuttled down to the Upper Colorado River for a four-mile raft trip. This trip is great for families, or those just looking for a relaxing trip along a scenic stretch of river, which includes a stop at a natural hot springs – the perfect way to explore the canyon that can only be experienced from the water. Minimum age is 7.

BLUE RIVER

Only Minutes From Summit County!

The perfect trip close to home. The Blue River offers exhilarating whitewater at 8,500 feet as it meanders through the Arapaho National Forest. This short trip starts with 3 miles of fairly tame water and finishes up with 3 great miles of majestic Class II-III whitewater. Minimum age is 7.

Departs Summit County Outpost at 9:00 a.m., noon, and 3:00 p.m.

2-HOUR HAPPY HOUR™ ON TEN MILE CREEK

Ten Mile Creek is the newest commercially run river in the state of Colorado, pioneered by KODI Rafting. This is an intense four mile, Class IV run, dropping 110 feet per mile in the upper stretch. After floating through the Town of Frisco, we'll finish up at the the Frisco Bay Marina, where appetizers and drink specials will be provided as we watch the sun set from Lake Dillon. Use fees and all gear are included. We ask that all participants are in good physical condition, and have previous rafting experience. Minimum age is 16.

Departs Frisco Bay Marina daily at 4:30 p.m.
