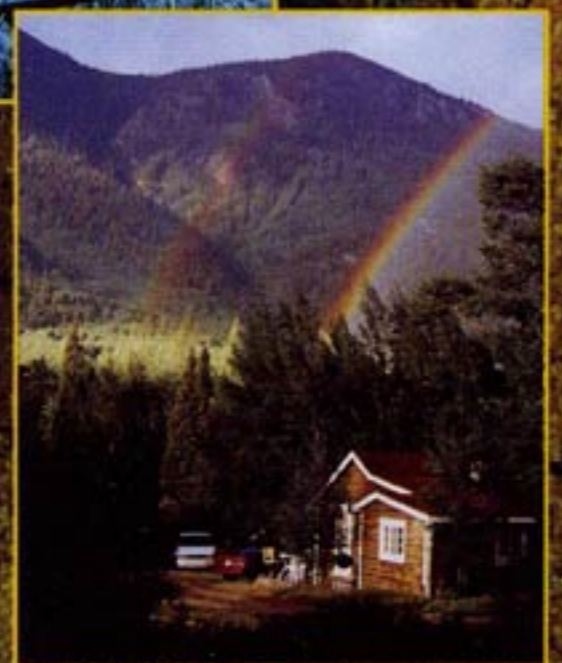

The Lodge Cabin

5 bedrooms upstairs, 4 1/2 baths. Small groups of up to 12 may choose to rent the entire Lodge as a cabin. PLEASE NOTE: No pets are allowed in the Lodge.

The Barn

4 Bedroom, Full Bath. Known as the stable for the original roadhouse, this spacious creekside cabin sleeps 8 and is perfect for small family gatherings and groups.

Beaver Lodge

2 Bedroom, Full Bath. Our largest 2 bedroom cabin. Its east facing porch invites you to relax and enjoy the changing moods of Lake Creek dancing nearby.

Prospector

1 Bedroom, 3/4 Bath. This cozy cabin is a perfect romantic getaway for just two people. Watch the hummingbirds and enjoy the entire valley from your east facing porch.

Trail's End

2 Bedroom, Full Bath. Farthest from the lodge, Trail's End offers the utmost seclusion, an expansive porch and quick access to Black Cloud Trail.

Tall Pine

2 Bedroom, 3/4 Bath. Relax on the porch and see if you can spot mountain goats as the sun and clouds dance across the mountain slopes.

Waterwheel

1 Bedroom, Full Bath. The presence of an old waterwheel on Black Cloud Creek babbling out back and the aspens whispering and quaking with each breeze set the mood for this charming cabin.

Rinker

1 Bedroom, Full Bath. Accessible Rinker Cabin occupies the west half of the new duplex built in 2000. The west deck is perfect for watching the sun set at the top of the valley or sit inside and enjoy the view of Rinker Peak while you toast your toes by the gas log fireplace. The unit is wheelchair accessible.

Cinnamon Bear

1 Bedroom plus loft, Full Bath. The east side of the duplex, this cabin is just right for couples or a small family. Situated perfectly to catch the morning sun on its deck, there is no better place to enjoy those first moments of the day.

Deposits

A 50% (100% of 1 night stay) deposit is due 14 days after making the reservation. The balance, plus tax is due upon arrival and may be paid by cash, check, travelers check or credit card.

Cancellations

There is a service charge for reservations canceled more than 30 days in advance. Deposits on reservations canceled less than 30 days in advance of arrival will be refunded if the reservation is re-rented, less the service charge.

CHECK-IN TIME: 3:00 PM TO 7:00 PM

CHECK-OUT TIME: BY 10:30 AM (UNLESS OTHERWISE ARRANGED)

No Smoking is allowed in the main lodge or the cabins for the safety and health of all our guests.

How to find us...

FROM DENVER: (approximately 2 hours and 20 minutes thru Leadville) Travel west on I-70 to exit 195, take Colorado Highway 91 south to Leadville.

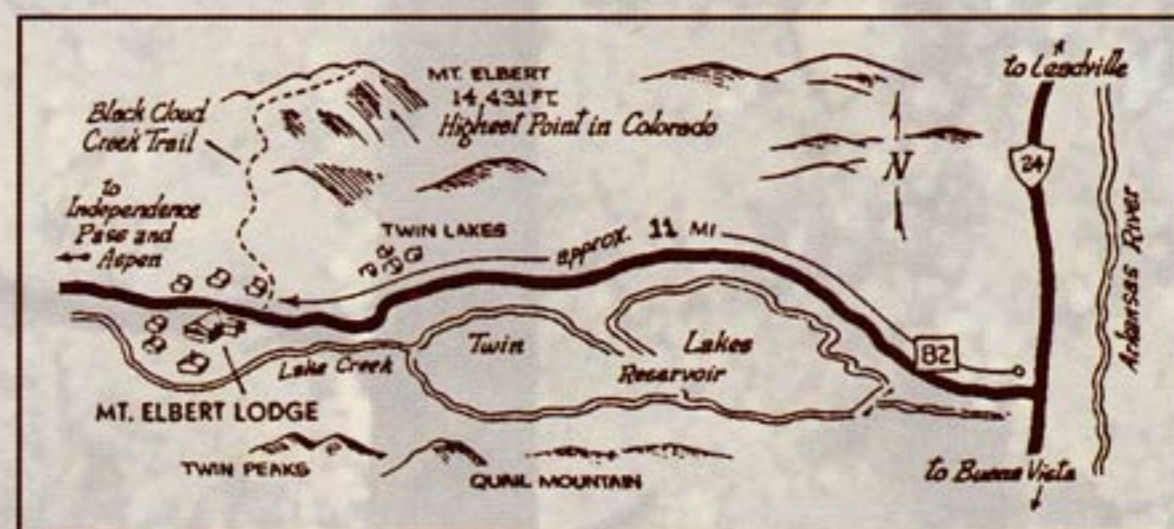
FROM LEADVILLE: Proceed 15 miles south on U.S. Highway 24 to Colorado Highway 82, turn right (west) and continue 11 miles (4 miles past Twin Lakes Village).

FROM COLORADO SPRINGS: (approximately 2 1/2 hours through Buena Vista) Follow U.S. Highway 24 north and west to Buena Vista.

FROM BUENA VISTA: Take U.S. Highway 24 towards Leadville 20 miles to Colorado Highway 82, turn left (west) and continue 11 miles (4 miles past Twin Lakes Village).

FROM ASPEN (SUMMER ROUTE ONLY)

The Lodge is 30 miles east on Colorado Highway 82, 13 miles down from the top of Independence Pass.
